

SIMS EUROSIM 2024 Submission Instructions

1. Submit a new contribution

Open EasyChair and access SIMS EUROSIM 2024 conference as an author and use the links in the upper part of the page.



New Submission for SIMS EUROSIM 2024

Follow the instructions, step by step, and then use the "Submit" button at the bottom of the form. The required fields are marked by *.

Author Information

For each author please fill out the form below. Some items on the form are explained here:

- **Email address** will only be used for communication with the authors. It will not appear in public Web pages of this conference. The email address can be omitted for not corresponding authors. These authors will also have no access to the submission page.
- **Web page** can be used on the conference Web pages, for example, for making the program. It should be a Web page of the author, not the Web page of her or his organization.
- Each author marked as a **corresponding author** will receive email messages from the system about this submission. There must be at least one corresponding author.

Fill ASCII descriptions **Title, Abstract and Keywords**. You can later **update information and authors**. This **Abstract** should be kept updated for the **Conference Program**.

Then choose the type of your contribution:

Please select topics relevant to your submission from the following list. Topics are typically used for assigning submissions to reviewers and for conference analytics.

Select one type. The abstract text (150-250 words) included in the submission form is sufficient. No abstract files are needed. The files can be submitted via the submission page within the deadlines shown at the conference website.

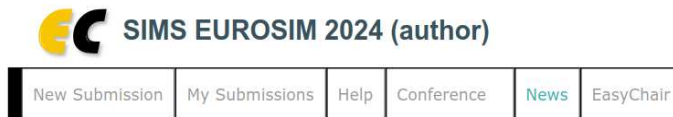
The submission page of each contribution is built **only once**. You can update it later.

This submission page is also used when submitting the **draft and final papers, presentations, posters, response to the reviewer comments and CVs**. See next page,

2. Update your contribution

Prepare your paper according to the **Author instructions** shown at the **conference website**. You must use the **IFAC conference templates** which are available there.

Then open EasyChair and access SIMS EUROSIM 2024 conference as an author and use the links in the upper part of the page.



My Submissions for SIMS EUROSIM 2024

Open “My Submissions for SIMS EUROSIM 2024” for updating information and files. You should log in as “author” or change to the role “author”. “SIMS EUROSIM 2024 (author)” with page “My Submissions for SIMS EUROSIM 2024” has two alternatives:

(1) Select from the UPPER BANNER “My Submissions” and there “Submission NN”. There you can update information. The alternative actions **at the upper right corner**:

- **Update information (if needed)** Title, Abstract, Keywords and select one Topic from alternatives.
- **Update authors (if needed)**: Name, Email, Country, Affiliation, Web page, corresponding (yes/no).

Then select “**Add or update files**” and upload your files to appropriate sections. There are papers, presentations, posters, responses to reviewers and CVs. The conference **WILL USE THESE FILES**.

(2) **DON'T USE the lower alternatives** are for the program and publication with EasyChair. **Clicking “access”** takes to the program talks and changes role to “program author”. The upper banner of the page changes to “SIMS EUROSIM 2024 (program author)”. The only alternatives are (EasyChair) slides and preprints. The conference **WILL NOT USE THESE FILES**.

The SIMS EUROSIM 2024 conference has an agreement with the Linköping Electronic Conference Proceedings Series which defines the publication practices. All the files are uploaded at the Submission page.

2.1 Paper

Camera ready manuscripts are submitted by uploading **your corrected paper** as a pdf file in the Files section “Paper”.

NOTE: The EasyChair Preprints are NOT used in publishing. You should not use EasyChair preprints, since they may cause problems in publishing. Please check that paper at your **Submission page** is updated and **remove your preprint files**.

2.2 Presentation

Presentations are submitted by uploading **your presentation** in an **appropriate form** in the Files section “Presentation”. The presentation files are collected from these submissions.

NOTE: The EasyChair Smart Slide Web site is NOT used in the smart program. **Remove your EasyChair slides**.

2.3 Poster

Poster presentations can be uploaded as **NEW submissions as topic "Poster"**. The information needed including authors, title, keywords and a short abstracts which is used in the program. **Then upload the poster file** in the **Files section "Poster"**.

2.4 Responses to reviewers

Responses to the reviewers' comments can be submitted by uploading **text file in pdf format** in the **Files section "Respond"**.

2.5 Short CVs

A short CV in pdf format can be submitted in the **Files section "CV"**.

Files

Paper. Upload your paper. The paper must be in PDF format (file extension .pdf)

Presentation. Upload your presentation (file extension .pdf, .ppt, .pptx).

poster. Upload your poster (file extension .pdf, .ppt, .pptx).

respond. Respond to the reviewers' comments in PDF format (file extension .pdf).

CV. Upload a short CV in PDF format (file extension .pdf).

If you filled out the form, press the 'Submit' button below. **Do not press the button twice: uploading may take time!**

The updates can be done as many times as needed until the **submission deadline**. The latest submission will be reviewed after the **submission deadline**.

3. Define a Thematic Session (CLOSED)

Thematic sessions can be proposed in the same submission page.

- Fill the author information as an organizer.
- Add the session title, abstract and keywords.
- Choose paper type “Thematic session”.

In this case, the file is the information of the session which includes:

- Name(s) and contact information of the organizer(s),
- Abstract (150-300 words),
- A list of at least 4 contributions containing (preliminary) paper titles, author names and contact information of the corresponding author.
- Please note that the contributions do not need to be of the same type.

The **authors of the contributions** should submit the **Author information, Title, Abstract and Keywords as new submissions.**
