
SIMS 2020 Submission Instructions

Open EasyChair and access SIMS 2020 conference as an author and use the links in the upper part of the page:



SIMS 2020 Conference program

All reviews sent to you can be found at the bottom of this page.

The authors should check the information of their submission. Use "Update information" in the upper right corner.

• Update the ASCII descriptions **Title**, **Abstract and Keywords** if needed and accept your changes by pressing the button "Update Information".

Program

• The **presenter** should be chosen. Check the current information in "**Program**" and change if needed. **Due date: September 18, 2020.**

SIMS 2020 Presentations

The presentations need to be submitted in advance as Powerpoint or PDF files. Select "Add or update files" and upload your presentation in the field "Presentation". Due date: September 18, 2020. The size of the file should not exceeds 2 MB. Uploading during the sessions is not possible. Prepare the presentation by using the Presentation template, see Author instructions of SIMS 2020.

Recording

The authors are to present online, so prerecording is not needed.

SIMS 2020 Book of Abstracts

The updated extended abstracts for the Book of Abstracts (templated) submission extended to September **30, 2020**. Select "Add or update files" and upload your extended abstract file in the field "Extended abstract", see Author instructions of SIMS 2020.

SIMS 2020 Proceedings

The proceedings will be published in Linköping Electronic Conference Proceedings Series.

- The reference lists are needed as separate word or text files. Select "Add or update files" and upload the file in the field "Reference list". Content: Title and authors are followed by the reference list of the paper. Due date: October 15, 2020.
- The proceedings will go to publishing October 30, 2020. Minor corrections requests are possible.
